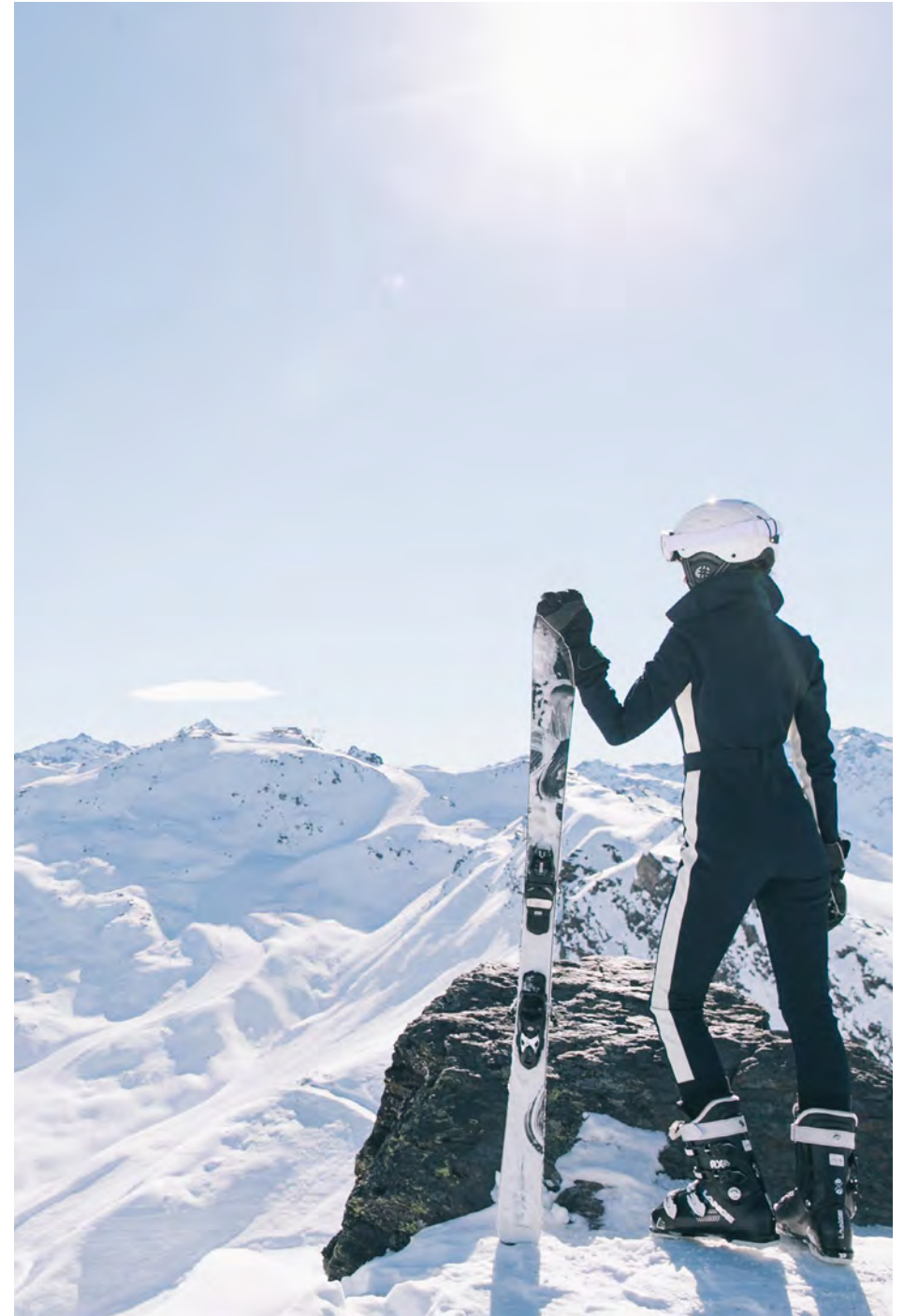

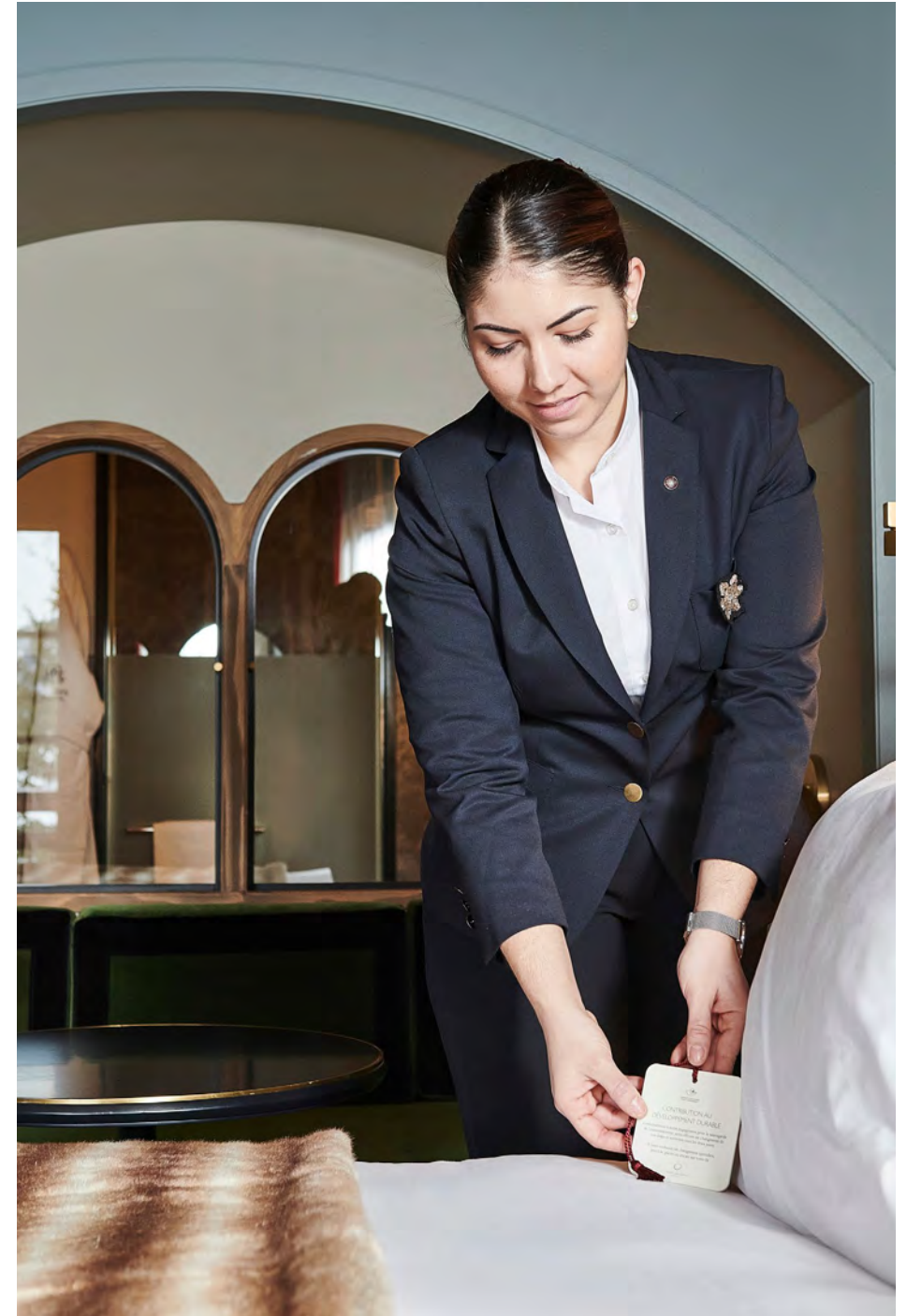
Environmental awareness
